# Small Business Reserve Program

- Prime Contracting Opportunities
- Provides opportunities for small business to compete on contracts against other small businesses.
- Agency is required to spend a minimum of 15% of procurement dollars with certified small businesses through the SBR program.
- Company must complete the SBR certification process to be eligible to participate.

# Minority Business Enterprise Program

- Subcontracting Opportunities
- Provides opportunities for minority owned businesses to participate on state contracts.
- Agency's goal is to award a minimum of 29% of total contract dollars to certified Minority Business Enterprises.
- Obtain certification through the MDOT Office of Minority Business Enterprise.

- Agency's goal is to award a minimum of 1% of total contract dollars to certified veteran-owned small businesses.
- Obtain certification through the U.S. Department of Veteran's Affairs Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization.

# MBE & VSBE Q&A

- How are set-asides and goals placed on contracts?
  - Procurement Review Group reviews each contract to determine:
    - If the procurement can be reserved for small business participation only.
    - If MBE and VSBE goals can be placed on the contract.
    - What an appropriate goal is.
- How can my company find out about opportunities?
  - Contracting opportunities will be advertised on eMaryland Marketplace.
  - Prime contractors identify and select MBE subcontractors to participate on contracts.
  - "SBR Only" procurements will be advertised on eMaryland Marketplace.
  - Attend business opportunities outreach events.
