Design/Bid/Build (D/B/B)	Design/Build (D/B)	Construction Management at Risk (CM)
Most Common DGS' Preferred contract mechanism	Client/Project Specific - A/E Team is contained within the Contractor's Sub-contractor list	Considered for Projects > \$5M with Complications
DGS advertises the Capital Project and requests RFP's from A/E firms, then after 100% bid Documents are approved The Construction Contract is Competitively Bid on eMM	The Design/Build Construction Contract is solicited as a Multi-Step Proposal on eMM by DGS Construction Procurement	On eMM, DGS Construction Procurement advertises a Request for Proposals (RFP) from CM firms which are submitted to a Qualifications Committee Review and Grading

Indefinite Quantity Contracts

- ◆ Design fees are limited to \$200,000 per assignment.
- **♦** Current Indefinite Quantity Contracts (IQC):
 - ◆ Construction Scheduling & Claims
 - ◆ Roofing Design & Engineering
 - ♦ Building Systems Commissioning
 - ◆ Architectural & Engineering
 - ◆ Construction Inspection & Testing
 - ◆ Technical Reviews of Public School Projects
 - Structural Design & Engineering
 - ♦ Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing Engineering
 - ◆ Civil Investigative, Design & Engineering Services



Small Design Contracts < \$25,000

Small Business Reserve (SBR) Only Contracts.

Four eligible disciplines:

- **♦** Architectural
- ♦ Mechanical Engineering
- Electrical Engineering
- ♦ Civil Engineering

For consideration, firm must submit to DGS:

- ♦ Letter of Interest
- ♦ Financial Documentation
- ♦ Standard Form 330 (SF-330)
- ◆ Professional Registration for Firm's Principal
- ♦ Professional Liability Insurance of \$500,000 or more

 - ◆ DGS & MDOT working through Administrative, Executive, & Legislative Review (AELR) Process
 - ◆ Public Comment 30 Days Winter 2017
 - ♦ Active 2018
